The department is a mixed metropolitan non-tertiary ED seeing approximately 60,000 presentations per annum. Redland ED is accredited for 36 months of ACEM training and also has terms in Anaesthetics (6 months) and General Paediatrics, as well as links to tertiary ICU, tertiary paediatric ED and tertiary adult ED terms as well as Special Skills Terms in Ultrasound and Medical Education/Simulation. A comprehensive, interactive education programme is offered which includes procedural training on models, multi-disciplinary simulation in our sim suite, hands-on ultrasound sessions, registrar-led sessions and both ACEM Primary and Fellowship Written and OSCE programmes.

TS4s also get non-clinical time to pursue supported Quality Improvement, Committee involvement or other projects to help build consultant-level skills and experience.
