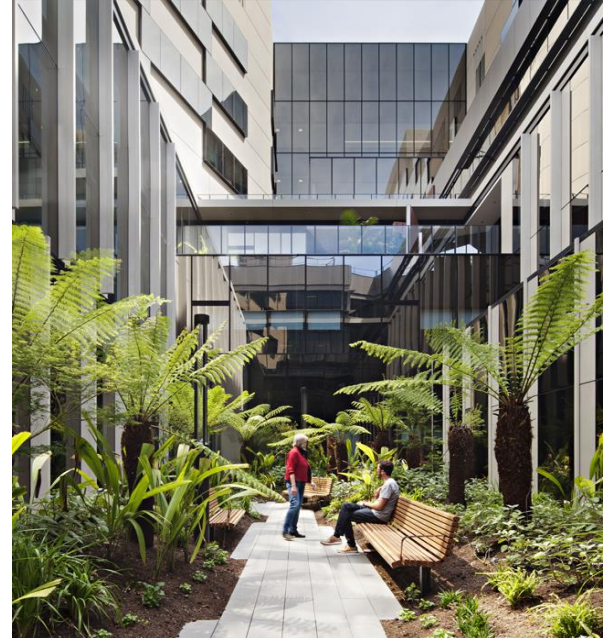


Bendigo Emergency Department Registrars 2021

Bendigo ED focusses on training highly competent emergency medicine clinicians in a well-developed academic training program.

Being a regional referral centre, you will gain experience in the whole breadth of Emergency Medicine in one hospital from paediatrics (23%) to trauma (we are a regional trauma centre) and everything in-between.

This includes procedures where there is no queue of people before you: do you know how to float a pacing wire or drain a quinsy?

We recently moved into a brand new hospital with 45 treatment spaces including 4 resus cubicles and 12 short stay beds, a helipad and a cath lab.
